Health and Safety Policy Statement 11th September 2018

British Gymnastics Foundation is committed to providing a safe environment for all staff, volunteers, participants and other personnel involved in British Gymnastics Foundation's charitable programmes. All staff, volunteers and other personnel have a responsibility to do everything practicable to prevent an accident or injury to themselves and to others who are involved in British Gymnastics Foundation's charitable programmes.

British Gymnastics Foundation aims to promote health and safety, so far as reasonably practicable, by ensuring:

- 1. The provision and maintenance of safe equipment for the delivery of charitable programmes.
- 2. The provision of relevant information to staff, volunteers and other personnel as is necessary to ensure health and safety.
- 3. Maintenance of safe environments, including a means of access in a condition that is safe and without risk to health.
- 4. Progressive identification and assessment of all risk, taking measures to eliminate or control it.
- 5. Compliance with statutory regulation on health and safety and welfare of staff, volunteers and other personnel involved in our charitable programmes.
- 6. The health, safety and welfare of vulnerable people involved in our charitable programmes is addressed through positive action.
- 7. Effective measures, such as fire alarms, are in place to deal with emergencies.

This list is not exhaustive and represents general principles followed by British Gymnastics Foundation in respect of health and safety.
